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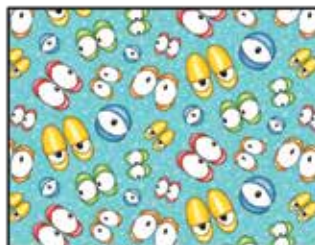

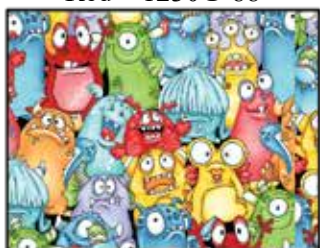

1 1/8 yards (1.03m)	Twinkle Basics - Black (B)	135-99*
1/2 yard (0.46m)	Twinkle Basics - Orange (C)	135-33
1/4 yard (0.23m)	Monsters & Stars Glow - Black (D)	1231G-99
1/4 yard (0.23m)	Tossed Monsters & Footsteps Glow - Red (E)	1230G-88
1/4 yard (0.23m)	Eyes Glow - Black (F)	1232G-99
1/4 yard (0.23m)	Packed Monsters Glow - Multi (G)	1233G-184
1/2 yard (0.46m)	Small Colored Blocks Glow - Aqua (H)	1238G-11
3/8 yard (0.35m)	Bias Plaid Glow - Multi (I)	1236G-84
3 yards (2.75m)	Eyes Glow - Aqua (Backing)	1232G-11

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24 Inch Monster Panel Glow - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 22 1/2" x 30 1/2" rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Twinkle Basics - Black (B), cut:

- (2) 1 1/2" x 38 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x 24 1/2" WOF strips.
- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips.
- (5) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Twinkle Basics - Orange (C), cut:

- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips.
- (5) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.

From the Monsters & Stars Glow - Black (D), cut:

- (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 1/2" squares.

From the Tossed Monsters & Footsteps Glow - Red (E), cut:

- (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 6 1/2" squares.

From the Eyes Glow - Black (F), cut:

- (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 6 1/2" squares.

From the Packed Monsters Glow - Multi (G), cut:

- (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 6 1/2" squares.

From the Small Colored Blocks Glow - Aqua (H), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 56 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 43 1/2" strips.

From the Bias Plaid Glow - Multi (I), cut:

- (2) 5" x 22 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Eyes Glow - Aqua (Backing), cut:

- (2) 51" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 51" x 67" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 5" x 22 1/2" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the 22 1/2" x 30 1/2" Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

Trim the block to measure 22 1/2" x 38 1/2".

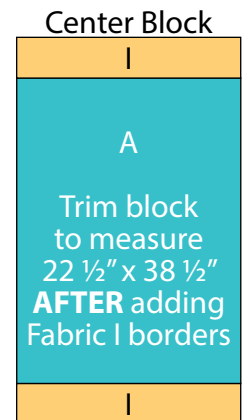

2. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 6 1/2" Fabric G square. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric G square to make (1) 8 1/2" Block One square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (5) Block One squares total.

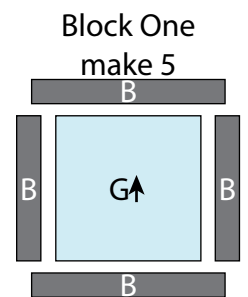

3. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figures 3-5 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (6) Block Two squares, (5) Block Three squares and (4) Block Four squares.

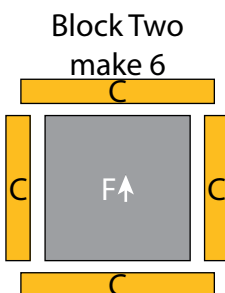

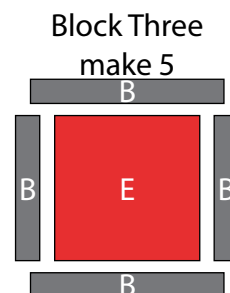

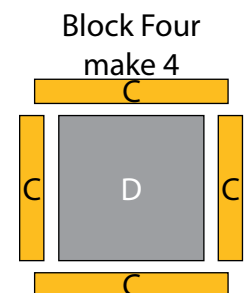

4. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Three square, (1) Block Two square and (1) Block One square, in that order from top to bottom, to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 6).

Left Side Border

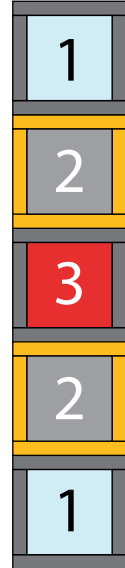

Right Side Border

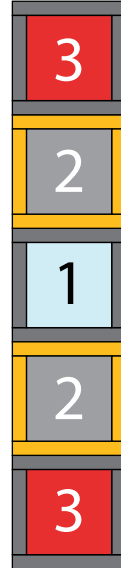

5. Repeat Step 4 and refer to Figures 7-8 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Right Side Border, the Top Border and the Bottom Border.

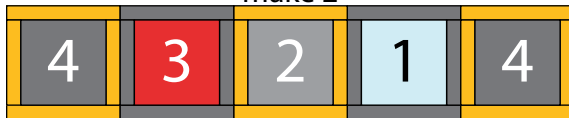

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

6. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 38 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 24 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

7. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.

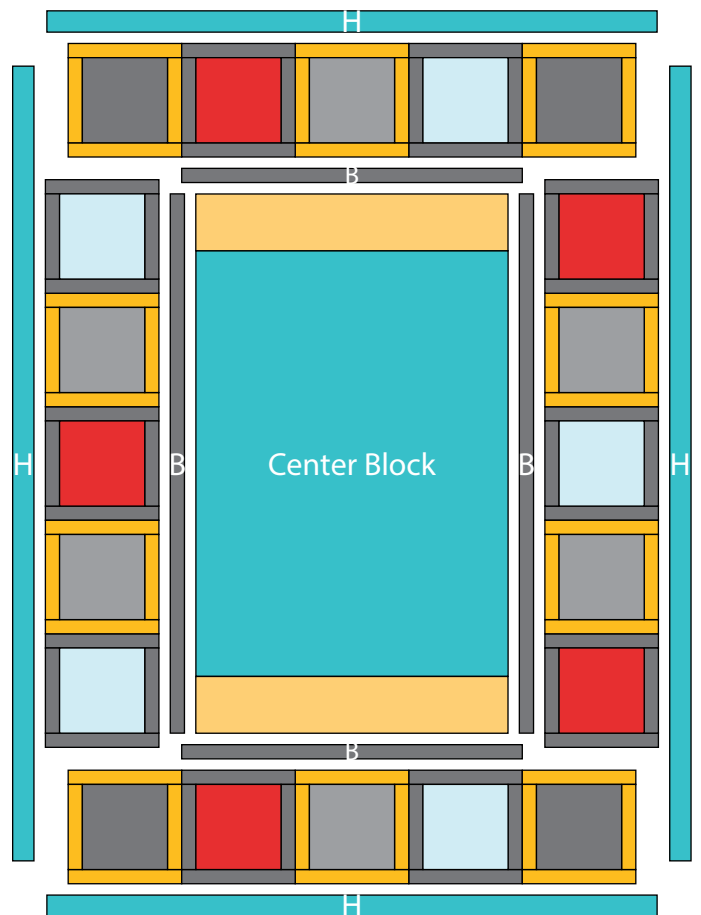
8. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

9. Sew (1) 2" x 56 1/2" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 43 1/2" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

10. Layer and quilt as desired.

11. Sew the (6) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

12. Bind as desired.
