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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From each of Fabrics A, B, D, E, G, and H, cut:

- one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
 - twelve 3-1/2" squares of each fabric
- one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:
 - two 3" squares of each fabric

From each of Fabrics C, F, I, J, and K cut:

- one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
 - twelve 3-1/2" squares of each fabric
- one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:
 - one 3" square of each fabric

From Fabric L, cut:

- one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
 - twelve 3-1/2" squares of each fabric

From Fabric M, cut:

- sixteen 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
 - one-hundred and ninety-two 3-1/2" squares
- twenty-five 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:
 - six 3" x 20-1/2" rectangles
 - fourteen 3" x 9-1/4" rectangles
 - one-hundred and forty-four 3" squares
- Sew the remaining eight strips together, end-to-end, then subcut:
 - two 3" x 88" side borders
 - two 3" x 70-1/2" top/bottom borders

From Fabric N, cut:

- two 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
 - twelve 5-1/2" squares
- twelve 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
 - one-hundred and forty-four 3-1/2" squares
- four 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:
 - forty-eight 3" squares

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

























- nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 1: Pair a 3-1/2" Fabric A square with a 3-1/2" Fabric M square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 3" square. Repeat to make one-hundred and ninety-two M/N HSTs.



Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make:

Assemble the Blocks

Step 3: Gather two 3" Fabric M squares, one 3" Fabric N square, two A/M HSTs, two A/N HSTs, and two M/N HSTs. Arrange the squares and HSTs in three rows of three as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press. Make four A Corner Units.



Step 4: Gather two 3" Fabric M squares, one 3" Fabric N square, two B/M HSTs, two B/N HSTs, and two M/N HSTs. Arrange the squares and HSTs in three rows of three as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press. Make four B Corner Units.



Step 5: Gather two 3" Fabric M squares, one 3" Fabric N square, two C/M HSTs, two C/N HSTs, and two M/N HSTs. Arrange the squares and HSTs in three rows of three as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press. Make four C Corner Units.



Step 6: Gather two 3" Fabric M squares, one 3" Fabric N square, two D/M HSTs, two D/N HSTs, and two M/N HSTs. Arrange the squares and HSTs in three rows of three as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press. Make four D Corner Units.



Step 7: Gather two 3" Fabric M squares, one 3" Fabric N square, two E/M HSTs, two E/N HSTs, and two M/N HSTs. Arrange the squares and HSTs in three rows of three as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press. Make four E Corner Units.



Step 8: Gather two 3" Fabric M squares, one 3" Fabric N square, two F/M HSTs, two F/N HSTs, and two M/N HSTs. Arrange the squares and HSTs in three rows of three as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press. Make four F Corner Units.



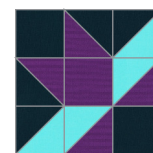
Step 9: Gather two 3" Fabric M squares, one 3" Fabric N square, two G/M HSTs, two G/N HSTs, and two M/N HSTs. Arrange the squares and HSTs in three rows of three as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press. Make four G Corner Units.



Step 10: Gather two 3" Fabric M squares, one 3" Fabric N square, two H/M HSTs, two H/N HSTs, and two M/N HSTs. Arrange the squares and HSTs in three rows of three as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press. Make four H Corner Units.



Step 11: Gather two 3" Fabric M squares, one 3" Fabric N square, two I/M HSTs, two I/N HSTs, and two M/N HSTs. Arrange the squares and HSTs in three rows of three as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press. Make four I Corner Units.



Step 12: Gather two 3" Fabric M squares, one 3" Fabric N square, two J/M HSTs, two J/N HSTs, and two M/N HSTs. Arrange the squares and HSTs in three rows of three as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press. Make four J Corner Units.



Step 13: Gather two 3" Fabric M squares, one 3" Fabric N square, two K/M HSTs, two K/N HSTs, and two M/N HSTs. Arrange the squares and HSTs in three rows of three as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press. Make four K Corner Units.



Step 14: Gather two 3" Fabric M squares, one 3" Fabric N square, two L/M HSTs, two L/N HSTs, and two M/N HSTs. Arrange the squares and HSTs in three rows of three as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press. Make four L Corner Units.



Step 15: Gather two 3" Fabric M squares, two A/M HSTs, and two M/N HSTs. Arrange the squares and HSTs in three rows of two as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press. Make four A Side Units.



Step 16: Gather two 3" Fabric M squares, two B/M HSTs, and two M/N HSTs. Arrange the squares and HSTs in three rows of two as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press. Make four B Side Units.



Step 17: Gather two 3" Fabric M squares, two C/M HSTs, and two M/N HSTs. Arrange the squares and HSTs in three rows of two as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press. Make four C Side Units.



Step 18: Gather two 3" Fabric M squares, two D/M HSTs, and two M/N HSTs. Arrange the squares and HSTs in three rows of two as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press. Make four D Side Units.



Step 19: Gather two 3" Fabric M squares, two E/M HSTs, and two M/N HSTs. Arrange the squares and HSTs in three rows of two as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press. Make four E Side Units.



Step 20: Gather two 3" Fabric M squares, two F/M HSTs, and two M/N HSTs. Arrange the squares and HSTs in three rows of two as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press. Make four F Side Units.



Step 21: Gather two 3" Fabric M squares, two G/M HSTs, and two M/N HSTs. Arrange the squares and HSTs in three rows of two as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press. Make four G Side Units.



Step 22: Gather two 3" Fabric M squares, two H/M HSTs, and two M/N HSTs. Arrange the squares and HSTs in three rows of two as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press. Make four H Side Units.



Step 23: Gather two 3" Fabric M squares, two I/M HSTs, and two M/N HSTs. Arrange the squares and HSTs in three rows of two as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press. Make four I Side Units.



Step 24: Gather two 3" Fabric M squares, two J/M HSTs, and two M/N HSTs. Arrange the squares and HSTs in three rows of two as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press. Make four J Side Units.



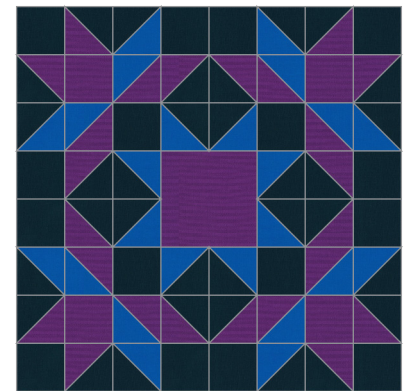
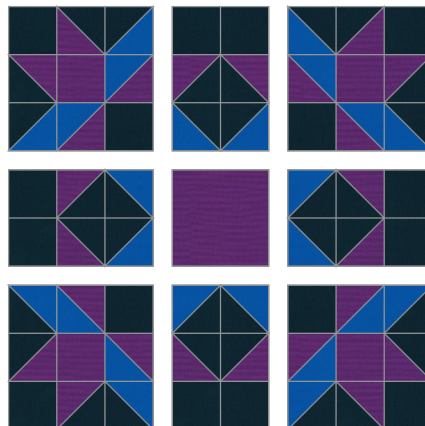
Step 25: Gather two 3" Fabric M squares, two K/M HSTs, and two M/N HSTs. Arrange the squares and HSTs in three rows of two as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press. Make four K Side Units.



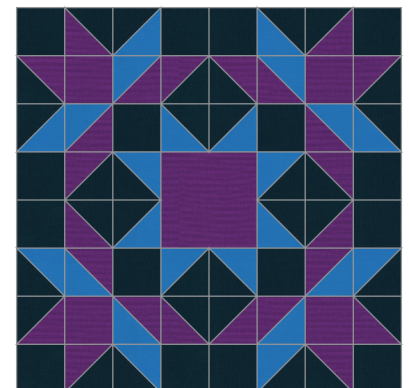
Step 26: Gather two 3" Fabric M squares, two L/M HSTs, and two M/N HSTs. Arrange the squares and HSTs in three rows of two as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press. Make four L Side Units.



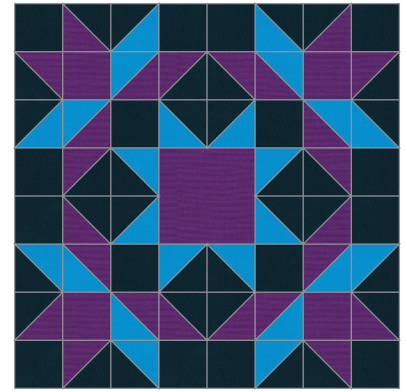
Step 27: Gather the four A Corner Units, four A Side Units, and one 5-1/2" Fabric N square. Arrange the units and square in three rows of three as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press.



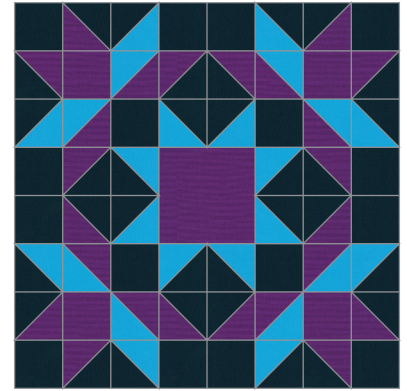
Step 28: Gather the four B Corner Units, four B Side Units, and one 5-1/2" Fabric N square. Arrange the units and square in three rows of three as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press.



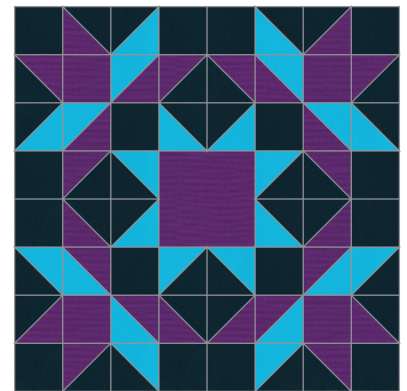
Step 29: Gather the four C Corner Units, four C Side Units, and one 5-1/2" Fabric N square. Arrange the units and square in three rows of three as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press.



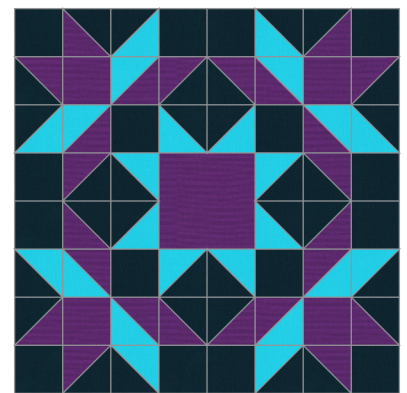
Step 30: Gather the four D Corner Units, four D Side Units, and one 5-1/2" Fabric N square. Arrange the units and square in three rows of three as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press.



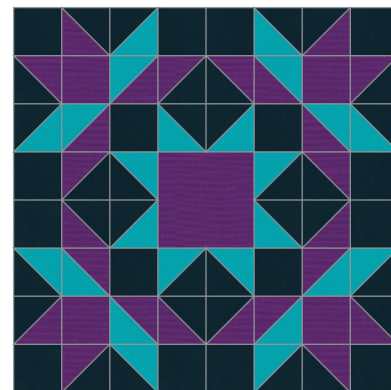
Step 31: Gather the four E Corner Units, four EE Side Units, and one 5-1/2" Fabric N square. Arrange the units and square in three rows of three as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press.



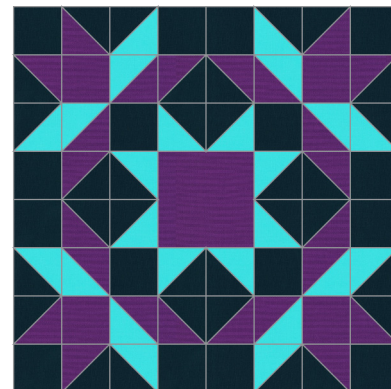
Step 32: Gather the four F Corner Units, four F Side Units, and one 5-1/2" Fabric N square. Arrange the units and square in three rows of three as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press.



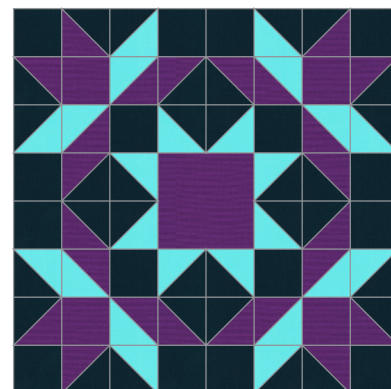
Step 33: Gather the four G Corner Units, four G Side Units, and one 5-1/2" Fabric N square. Arrange the units and square in three rows of three as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press.



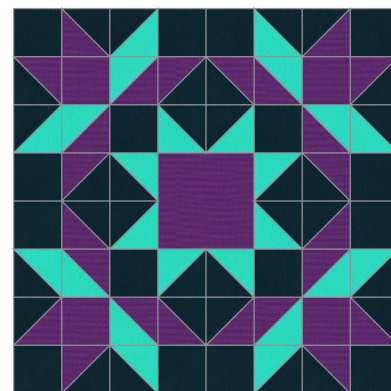
Step 34: Gather the four H Corner Units, four H Side Units, and one 5-1/2" Fabric N square. Arrange the units and square in three rows of three as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press.



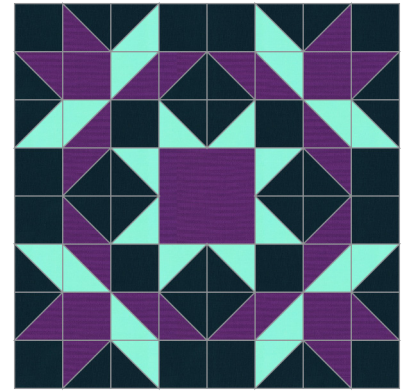
Step 35: Gather the four I Corner Units, four I Side Units, and one 5-1/2" Fabric N square. Arrange the units and square in three rows of three as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press.



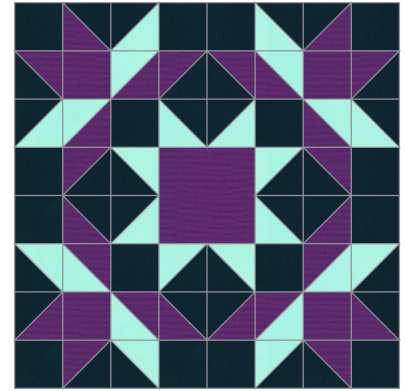
Step 36: Gather the four J Corner Units, four J Side Units, and one 5-1/2" Fabric N square. Arrange the units and square in three rows of three as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press.



Step 37: Gather the four K Corner Units, four K Side Units, and one 5-1/2" Fabric N square. Arrange the units and square in three rows of three as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press.



Step 38: Gather the four L Corner Units, four L Side Units, and one 5-1/2" Fabric N square. Arrange the units and square in three rows of three as shown. Sew them together to form the rows, then press. Sew the rows together, then press.



Assemble the Sashing Strips

Step 39: Gather one 3" Fabric A square, one 3" Fabric B square, one 3" Fabric C square, two 3" x 9-1/4" Fabric M rectangles, and two 3" x 20-1/2" Fabric M rectangles. Sew the squares and rectangles together in a row as shown, then press.



Step 40: Gather one 3" Fabric D square, one 3" Fabric E square, one 3" Fabric F square, two 3" x 9-1/4" Fabric M rectangles, and two 3" x 20-1/2" Fabric M rectangles. Sew the squares and rectangles together in a row as shown, then press.



Step 41: Gather one 3" Fabric G square, one 3" Fabric H square, one 3" Fabric I square, two 3" x 9-1/4" Fabric M rectangles, and two 3" x 20-1/2" Fabric M rectangles. Sew the squares and rectangles together in a row as shown, then press.



Step 42: Gather one 3" Fabric A square and two 3" x 9-1/4" rectangles. Sew the two rectangles to opposite edges of the square, then press.



Step 43: Gather one 3" Fabric B square and two 3" x 9-1/4" rectangles. Sew the two rectangles to opposite edges of the square, then press.



Step 44: Gather one 3" Fabric D square and two 3" x 9-1/4" rectangles. Sew the two rectangles to opposite edges of the square, then press.



Step 45: Gather one 3" Fabric E square and two 3" x 9-1/4" rectangles. Sew the two rectangles to opposite edges of the square, then press.



Step 46: Gather one 3" Fabric G square and two 3" x 9-1/4" rectangles. Sew the two rectangles to opposite edges of the square, then press.



Step 47: Gather one 3" Fabric H square and two 3" x 9-1/4" rectangles. Sew the two rectangles to opposite edges of the square, then press.



Step 48: Gather one 3" Fabric J square and two 3" x 9-1/4" rectangles. Sew the two rectangles to opposite edges of the square, then press.



Step 49: Gather one 3" Fabric K square and two 3" x 9-1/4" rectangles. Sew the two rectangles to opposite edges of the square, then press.



Assemble the Quilt

Step 50: Arrange the blocks into four rows of three blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Separate the blocks with the sashing strips made in Steps 42-49.

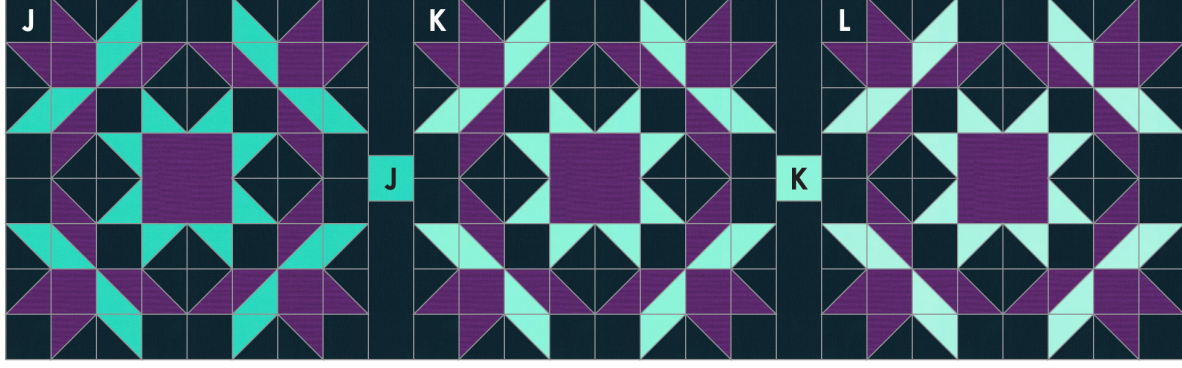
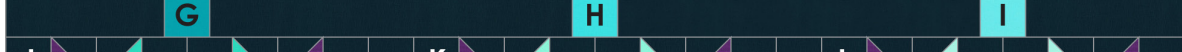
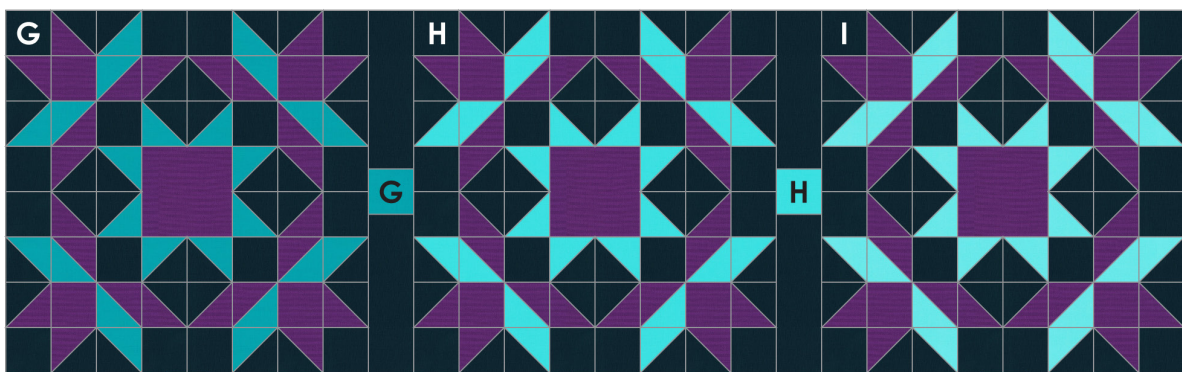
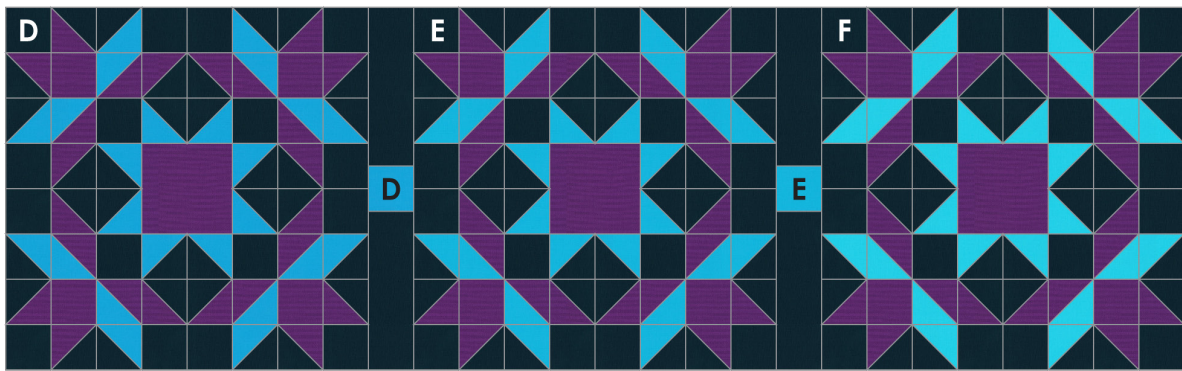
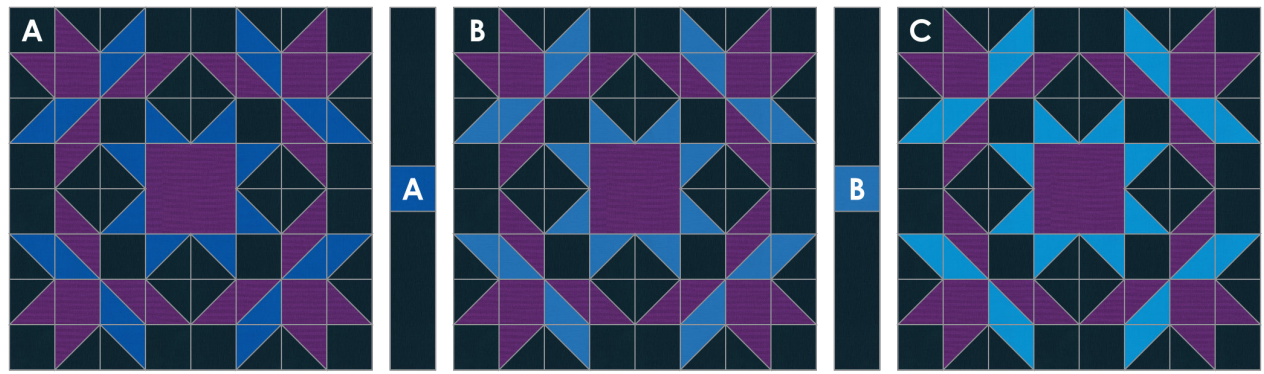
Step 51: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press.

Step 52: Separate the rows with the sashing strips made in Steps 39-41.

Step 53: Sew the rows and sashing strips together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Step 54: Sew the side borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!



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
