## Constructing A Block

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square. Place square, right sides together, on (1)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B square. Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HST units. Open and press. Align diagonal seam of HST units with 45 degree line on quilting ruler, trim units to measure 3" x 3" unfinished. Make (4) units.



2. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3" Fabric D rectangle to the right of step 1 unit, followed by (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4" Fabric rectangle to the bottom. Make a total of (2) units, and (2) mirror-imaged units.

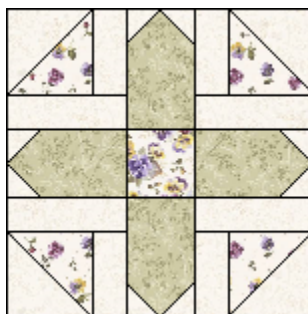
3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square. Place square, right sides together, at the top left corner of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4" Fabric E rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Repeat with another  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square at the top right corner of the same Fabric E rectangle. Make a total of (4) units.



4. Sew (2) step 2 units to the opposite sides of (1) step 3 unit to make a row unit. Make a total of (2) row units.

5. Sew (2) step 3 units to the opposite sides of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square to make a row unit.

6. Sew step 4 row units to the opposite long sides of step 5 row unit to complete (1) A Block. Block measures  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.

## Constructing B Block

1. Sew (2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric G strips to the opposite long sides of (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric D strip to make a strip set. Make a total of (2) strip sets. Subcut (48) units at  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " intervals.



2. Sew (2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric D strips to the opposite long sides of (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric G strip to make a strip set. Subcut (24) units at  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " intervals.



3. Sew (2) step 1 units to the opposite sides of (1) step 2 unit to make a 9-patch unit.



4. Sew (2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D rectangles to the opposite sides of step 3 unit.



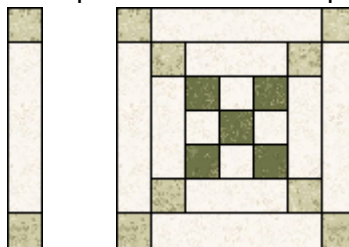
5. Sew (2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric E strips to the opposite long sides of (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip. Make a total of (2) strip sets. Subcut (48) units at  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " intervals. Sew (2) units to the top and bottom of step 4 unit.



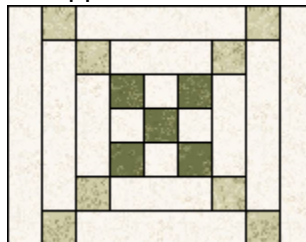
6. Sew (2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D rectangles to the opposite sides of step 5 unit.



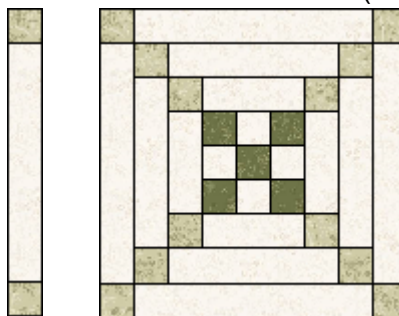
7. Sew (2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric E strips to the opposite long sides of (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip. Make a total of (2) strip sets. Subcut (48) units at  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " intervals. Sew (2) units to the top and bottom of step 6 unit.



8. Sew (2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D rectangles to the opposite sides of step 7 unit.

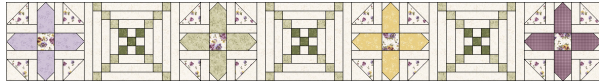


9. Sew (2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric E strips to the opposite long sides of (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip. Make a total of (2) strip sets. Subcut (48) units at  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " intervals. Sew (2) units to the top and bottom of step 8 unit to complete (1) B Block. Block measures  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make a total of (24) blocks.



## Quilt top assembly

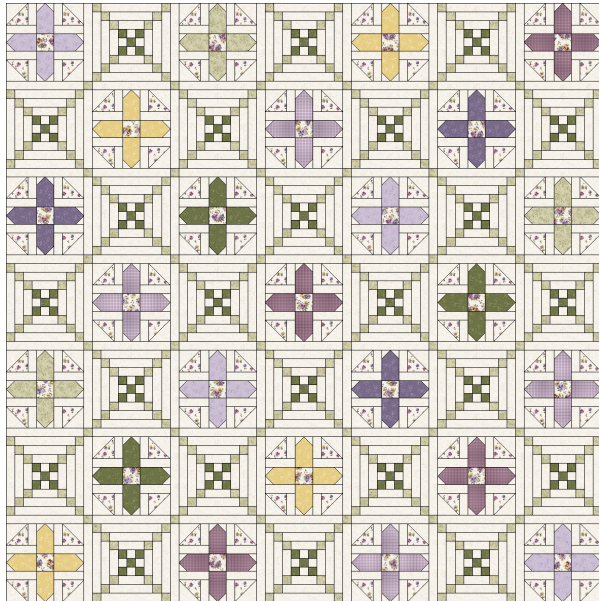
1. Pieced rows. Refer to quilt image for block placement, sew together pieced blocks, alternating with (6)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D rectangles, to make a pieced row. Make a total of (7) pieced rows. Row 1 is shown below.



2. Piece (7)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D rectangles, alternating with (6)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E squares, to make a pieced sashing row. Make a total of (6) pieced sashing rows.



3. Sew together pieced rows, alternating with pieced sashing rows, to complete quilt center.



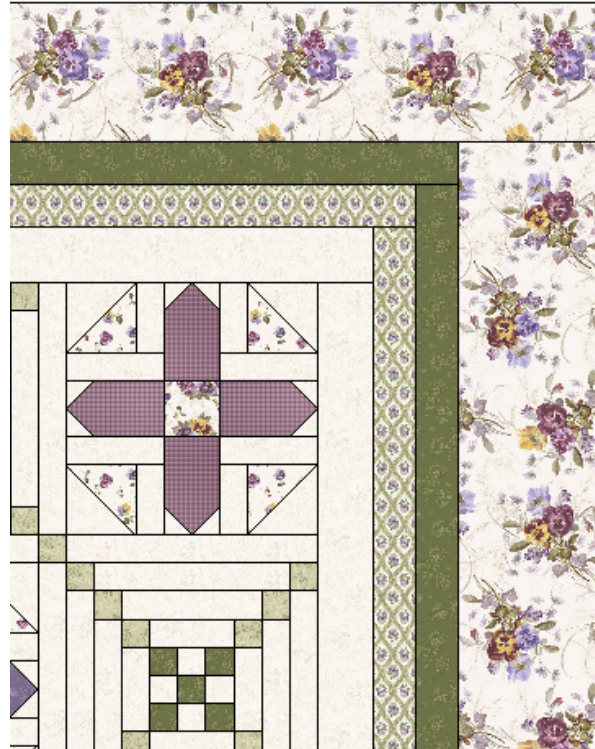
[Note: Border strips are sewn shorter lengths first to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by the longer lengths to the remaining sides of quilt center.

4. Inner border #1. Fabric D.  
(2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $69\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, then (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $73\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

5. Inner border #2. Fabric F.  
(2) 2" x  $73\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, then (2) 2" x  $76\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

6. Inner border #3. Fabric G.  
(2) 2" x  $76\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, then (2) 2" x  $79\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

7. Outer border. Fabric A.  
(2)  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $79\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, then (2)  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $89\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to complete quilt top.



## Finishing

1. Layer backing, batting and quilt top.
2. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind to complete the quilt.
