A		52403M-1	7/8	(1) 17-1/2" x WOF; subcut (2) 17-1/2" squares; cut each square in half once to make(4) triangles.(1) 6-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (4) 6-1/2" squares.
В		52403M-3	1-7/8	 (7) 7-1/2" x WOF strips; sew ends together. Subcut (2) 7-1/2" x 56-1/2" borders and (2) 7-1/2" x 70-1/2". (1) 3" x WOF strip; subcut (8) diamonds.
С		52404M-1	1	 (3) 4-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (24) 4-1/2" squares. Cut each square in half once to make (48) triangles. (1) 4" x WOF strip; subcut (8) 4" squares. (3) 3-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (32) 3-1/2" squares. Cut each square in half once to make (64) triangles.




Note: Measure and mark the end of the seamline at the point and side corner on the wrong side, if necessary, to ensure accuracy when sewing the diamonds together.

1. Sew (2) **B** diamonds together beginning at the center point and ending at the side corner of the seamline to make a diamond pair. Make 4.




- **2.** Sew (1) **B** diamond of the diamond pair to (1) **C** 4" square beginning and ending at the corners of the seamline.
- **3.** Sew second **B** diamond to adjacent side of **C** 4" square beginning and ending at the corners of the seamline diamond pair units. Make 4.

- **4.** Sew (2) **B** diamond pair units together along the side of the diamond ending at the corners of the seamline. Make 2.
- **5.** Following steps 2-3, sew sides of diamonds to (1) **C** 4" square to make half star units. Make 2.




- **6.** Sew (2) half star units together along the sides of the diamonds beginning and ending at the corners of the seamline.
- **7.** Following steps 2-3, sew sides of diamonds to (2) **C** 4" squares to make star center. Make 1.



- **8.** Sew (1) **D** diamond to (1) **G** diamond beginning and ending at the corners of the seamline. Sew (1) **G** diamond to **D** side of diamond pair to make **GDG** 3-diamond unit.
- **9.** Sew (2) **C** 4-1/2" triangles to 3-diamond unit using the technique in steps 2-3. Do not end stitching at marked outer point of diamonds; sew to edge of fabric. Make 4.
- **10.** Following steps 8-9 make 3-diamond units alternating (2) **D** diamonds and (1) **G** diamond to make a **DGD** 3-diamond unit. Add C triangles. Make 4.




11. Sew (4) **GDG** 3-diamond units alternating with (4) **DGD** 3-diamond units to the **C** squares beginning and ending at the corners of the seamline.





- **12.** Sew the 3-diamond units together beginning at the corner of the seamline and ending at the outer edge of the fabric to make an octagon. Make 1.
- **13.** Sew (4) **F** 8" triangles to octagon to make the Center Block. Center Block should measure 24-1/2" square including seam allowance. Make 1.

- **14.** Sew (1) I 2-1/2" x 24-1/2" strip to the sides of the Center Block. Sew (2) H 2-7/8" triangles to ends of (2) I 2-1/2" x 24-1/2" strips. Sew to remaining sides of the Center Block.
- **15.** Sew (1) **A** 17-1/2" triangles to sides of **I** 2-1/2" x 24-1/2" strips to make quilt center. Quilt center should measure approximately 37-1/2" square including seam allowance.

PATCHWORK BORDER

- **16.** Following step 1 sew (1) **E** diamond to one **G** diamond.
- **17.** Following steps 2-3 substituting (1) **C** 4-1/2" triangle for the **C** 4" square.
- **18.** Sew (2) **C** 3-1/2" triangles to the diamonds to make a diamond border unit. Diamond border units should measure 6-1/2" x 5-1/2" including seam allowance. Make 32.

19. Sew (8) diamond border units together so patchwork border measures 6-1/2" x 40-1/2" including seam allowance. Make 4.


20. Sew (2) A 6-1/2" squares to the ends of (2) patchwork borders. Make 2.

BORDERS

- **21.** Following the Quilt Layout on page 6, sew (1) **D** 2" x 37-1/2" border to sides of quilt center. Sew (2) **H** 2" squares to (2) **D** 2" x 37-1/2" borders. Sew to top and bottom of quilt center.
- **22.** Sew (1) patchwork border without squares to sides of quilt. Note orientation of diamonds. Sew patchwork borders with squares to top and bottom of quilt matching seams.
- **23.** Sew (1) I 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" borders to sides of quilt. Sew (2) H 2-1/2" squares to (2) I 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" borders. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.
- **24.** Sew (1) **B** (2) 7-1/2" \times 56-1/2" borders to sides of quilt. Sew (2) **B** 7-1/2" \times 70-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.





QUILT LAYOUT

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **H** 2-1/4" strips.
