

### **Proud Rooster**

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

#### 1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

**Fabric A** - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 4 panels to approximately 10-1/2" x 14-1/2"

Fabric B - Cut (3) 4" strips, subcut (8) 4" x 14" strips

**Fabric C** - Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips (or fussy cut if desired)

Fabric D - Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric E - Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (24) 3" squares

Fabric F - Cut (4) 4" strips, subcut (8) 4" x 20" strips


**Fabric G** - Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 3-1/2" x 7" pieces and (8) 3" squares

Fabric H - Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (16) 3" squares and (8) 2-1/2" squares

**Fabric I** - Cut (7) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (8) 1-3/4" x 18" and (8) 1-3/4" x 11" strips

#### 2. Piecing Order:

1. Stitch **Fabric I** 1-3/4" x 11" strips to sides of a **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-3/4" x 18" **Fabric I** strips to top and bottom of panel. *Trim bordered panel to 12-1/2" x 16-1/2" (unfinished)*. Make a total of 4 **Block 1**.



Block 1 - Make 4

Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints. Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric. 2. On the wrong side of all of the **Fabric E** 3" squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Draw 2 lines 1/4" on each side of first line.



3. Arrange a marked **Fabric E** 3" square right sides together with a **Fabric G** 3" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 2-1/2" square. Make a total of 16 Unit 1. In the same manner, make 32 Unit 2 with fabrics indicated.












Repeat 8 times for 16 units.


Make 32

4. Arrange 2 Unit 2 on each short end of a **Fabric C** 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" strip as shown. Stitch units together (2-1/2" x 4-1/2" unfinished). Sew to sides of the **Fabric C** piece. Make 2 Unit 3 (4-1/2" x 16-1/2" unfinished).




5. Arrange 2 **Fabric H** 2-1/2" squares and 6 Unit 2 above and below a Unit 3. Sew squares and units into rows (2-1/2" x 16-1/2" unfinished). Stitch rows above and below Unit 3. Make a total of 2 **Block 2** (8-1/2" x 16-1/2" unfinished).

6. Sew a **Fabric B**4" x 14" strip
centered between **Fabric G** 3-1/2" x 7"
and **Fabric F** 4" x 20"
strips as shown.
Make a total of
8 Unit 4
(10-1/2" tall x 20" wide unfinished).




Block 2 - Make 2

## **Proud Rooster**

7. From a Unit 4, cut a triangle 19-1/4" wide x 9-5/8" tall as shown. Cut a total of 4 Unit 5.





- 8. Sew 2 Unit 5 together along short edges as shown.

  Make a total of 2 **Block 3** (18-7/8" x 18-7/8" x 26 3/4" unfinished).
  - Block 3 Make 2

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9. From a Unit 4, cut a triangle 18-1/4" wide x 9-1/8" tall as shown. Cut a total of 4 Unit 6.






11. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of units and blocks.

- 12. Arrange all **Block 1**, **Block 2**, and Unit 1 in 3 vertical rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (32-1/2" x 34-1/2" unfinished).
- 13. Center each **Block 3** long edge above and below the quilt center. Stitch blocks to quilt center. Press seams to quilt center.
- 14. Center each **Block 4** long edge on right and left sides of the quilt center. Stitch blocks to quilt center. Press seams to quilt center.
- 15. The quilt measures approximately 41-1/2" square (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric J**) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 16. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric D**) and enjoy!!
