# Cocoa Sweet

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

## 1. Cut the following:

*If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.*

**Fabric A** - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 4 panels to approximately 11-1/2" x 16-1/2"

**Fabric B** - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (4) 8-3/4" x 64" multi-stripe borders

**Fabric C** - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 3-1/2" squares and (10) 2-1/2" squares

Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces and (18) 2-1/2" squares

**Fabric D** - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 3-1/2" x 7-1/2" pieces and (4) 2-1/2" squares

**Fabric E** - Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" pieces, (8) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces and (8) 2-1/2" squares

**Fabric F** - Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (16) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces and (8) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" pieces

**Fabric G** - Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (16) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces

**Fabric H** - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (1) 3-1/2" square and (8) 2-1/2" squares  
Cut (7) 1-1/4" strips, subcut (8) 1-1/4" x 18" and (8) 1-1/4" x 12" strips

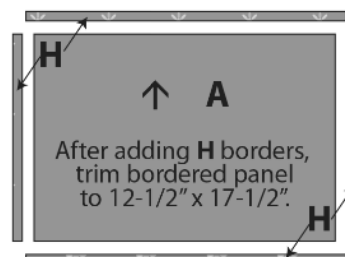
**Fabric I** - Cut (3) 1-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-1/2" x 43-1/2" borders  
Cut (2) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 41-1/2" borders

**Fabric J** - Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" pieces and (8) 2-1/2" squares

**Fabric K** - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

## 2. Piecing Order:

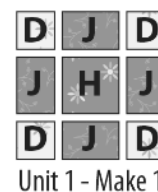
1. Stitch **Fabric H** 1-1/4" x 12" strips to sides of a **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/4" x 18" **Fabric H** strips to top and bottom of panel. **Trim bordered panel to 12-1/2" x 17-1/2" (unfinished).** Make a total of 4 **Block 1**.



Block 1 - Make 4

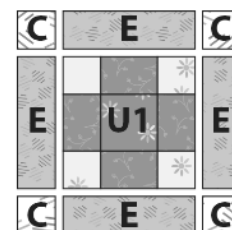
Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

2. Arrange 1 **Fabric H** 3-1/2" square, 4 **Fabric D** 2-1/2" squares, and 4 **Fabric J** 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" pieces in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete Unit 1 (7-1/2" square unfinished).



Unit 1 - Make 1

3. Arrange Unit 1, 4 **Fabric C** 2-1/2" squares, and 4 **Fabric E** 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" pieces in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 1 Unit 2 (11-1/2" square unfinished).



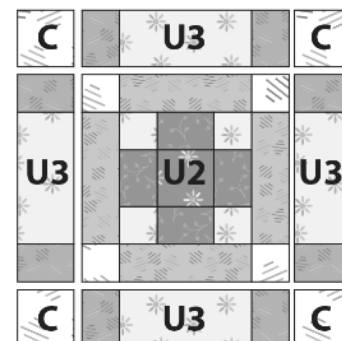
Unit 2 - Make 1

4. Stitch a **Fabric D** 3-1/2" x 7-1/2" piece 1 between 2 **Fabric F** 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" pieces as shown. Make a total of 4 Unit 3 (3-1/2" x 11-1/2" unfinished).



Unit 3 - Make 4

5. Arrange Unit 2, 4 Unit 3, and 4 **Fabric C** 3-1/2" squares in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete **Block 2** (17-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 2 - Make 1

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6. Stitch 1 each **Fabrics C** and **J** 2-1/2" squares together.



Make a total of 8 Unit 4a

(2-1/2" x 4-1/2" unfinished).

In the same manner, make 8 Unit 4b with fabrics indicated.

7. Arrange 1 Unit 4a, 1 **Fabric C**



2-1/2" square, 1 **Fabric C**



2-1/2" x 4-1/2" piece, and 2

**Fabric G** 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces

Unit 5a - Make 4

in 2 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together.

Make a total of 4 Unit 5a (6-1/2"

square unfinished).

8. In the same manner, make 4 each Units 5b-5d with fabrics and units indicated.



Unit 5b - Make 4    Unit 5c - Make 4    Unit 5d - Make 4

9. Arrange 1 each Units

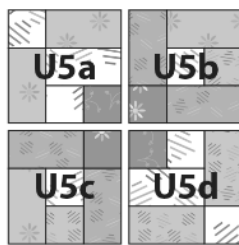
5a-5d in 2 rows. Stitch

into rows. Sew rows

together. Make a total

of 4 **Block 3** (12-1/2"

square unfinished).



Block 3 - Make 4

10. Refer to Quilt Layout

(Page 3) for arrangement and placement of

blocks and borders.

11. Arrange blocks in 3 rows. Stitch into rows.

Sew rows together completing quilt center

(41-1/2" square unfinished).

12. Sew **Fabric I** 1-1/2" x 41-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric I**

1-1/2" x 43-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

13. Center **Fabric B** 8-3/4" x 64"

borders on all sides of quilt

center with mug edge next

to quilt center. Stitch

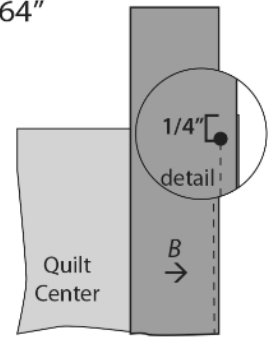
borders to sides starting

and stopping 1/4" from

corners of quilt center.

Do not trim. Press

borders out.



*Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.  
Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.*

14. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the

quilt right sides together so the outside edges

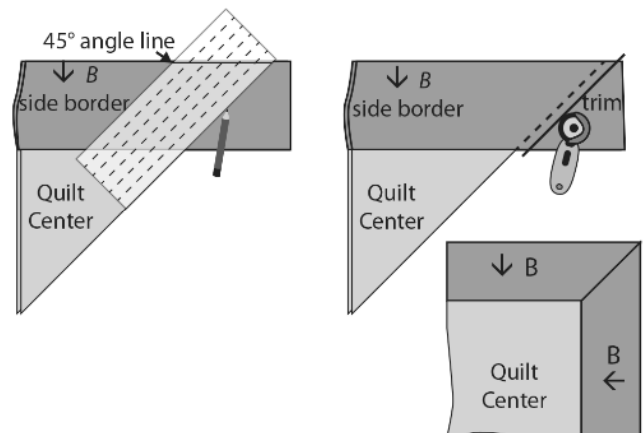
of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler,

mark from the end of border seams to outer

edges of borders. Stitch along marked line.

Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner

seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



15. The quilt measures approximately 60"

square (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric L**)

approximately 8" larger than the top.

16. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing

together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding

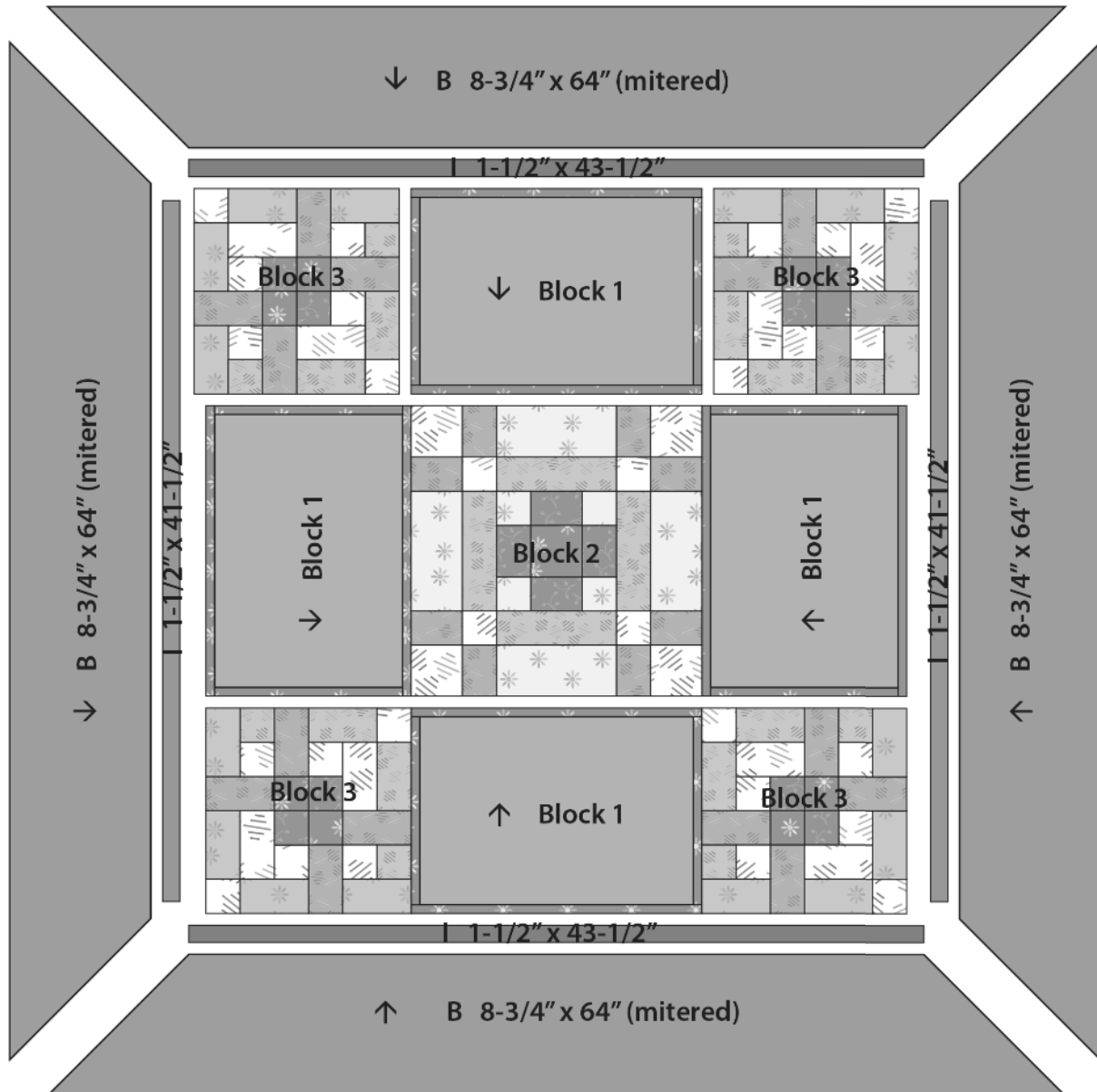
(**Fabric K**) and enjoy!!
