BASIC Medium Throw Quilt #12


Featuring Lakefront


Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.


All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - Cut (1) 15-1/2" strip, subcut
(2) 2-1/2" x 15-1/2", (4) 2-1/2" x 15", and
(8) 2-1/2" x 14" strips
Cut (2) 7-1/4" strips, subcut (10) 7-1/4"
squares then cut in half diagonally 
twice for 40 triangles
Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (10) 3-1/2" squares

Fabrics B, C, and D - From each fabric:
Cut (2) 7-1/4" strips, subcut (10) 7-1/4"
squares then cut in half diagonally 
twice for 40 triangles

Fabric E - Cut (3) 6-7/8" strips, subcut
(15) 6-7/8" squares then cut in half 
diagonally for 30 triangles
Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (10) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric F - Cut (3) 6-7/8" strips, subcut
(15) 6-7/8" squares [then cut in half 
diagonally for 30 triangles] and (14) 2-1/2"
squares

Fabric G - Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut
(20) 3-1/2" squares
Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

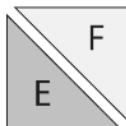
2. Piecing Order:

1. Arrange 1 each **Fabrics A, B, C,**
and **D** 7-1/4" triangles as shown.
Stitch triangles together. Make a
total of 40 **Block 1** (6-1/2" square
unfinished).



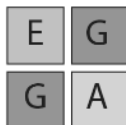
Block 1

2. Sew 1 each **Fabrics E** and **F** 6-7/8"
triangles together as shown. Make
a total of 30 **Block 2** (6-1/2" square
unfinished).



Block 2
Make 30

3. Arrange 1 each **Fabrics A** and **E**
and 2 **Fabric G** 3-1/2" squares in 2
rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew
rows together. Make a total of 10
Block 3 (6-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 3
Make 10

4. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 2) for
arrangement and placement of blocks, strips,
and squares.

5. Arrange blocks in 10 rows. Stitch into
rows. Sew rows together into quilt center
(48-1/2" x 60-1/2" unfinished).

6. Arrange 3 **Fabric F** 2-1/2" squares and
4 **Fabric A** 2-1/2" x 14" strips on each side of
quilt center. Stitch into pieced borders
(2-1/2" x 60-1/2" unfinished). Sew to right
and left sides of quilt center.

7. Arrange 4 **Fabric F** 2-1/2" squares,
2 **Fabric A** 2-1/2" x 15" strips, and 1 **Fabric A**
2-1/2" x 15-1/2" strip above and below quilt
center. Stitch into pieced borders
(2-1/2" x 52-1/2" unfinished). Sew to top and
bottom of quilt center.

8. The quilt measures approximately
52-1/2" x 64-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing
(**Fabric H**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

9. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing
together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding
(**Fabric G**) and enjoy!!
