End to End - Version 1 Featuring Garden Gate Roosters

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 5-1/2" x 18-1/2" stripe borders


Fabric C - Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips (binding) Cut (2) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 1-1/2" x 18-1/2" strips

Note: **Fabric A** prints in 5-Karat pack may vary from color quilt image.

2. Piecing Order:

- 1. Refer to Quilt Layout for arrangement and placement of squares and borders.
- 2. Arrange 40 **Fabric A** 5" squares in 4 rows of 10 squares each. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete quilt center (18-1/2" x 45-1/2" unfinished).

3. Stitch a **Fabric B** 5-1/2" x 18-1/2" border lengthwise between 2 **Fabric C** 1-1/2" x 18-1/2" strips. Make a total of 2 Pieced Borders (7-1/2" x 18-1/2" unfinished).




Pieced Border - Make 2

Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

- 4. Sew a Pieced Border to short ends of quilt center.
- 5. The quilt measures approximately 18-1/2" x 59-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric D**) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 6. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric C**) and enjoy!!
