BASIC Extra Large Throw Quilt #3

Featuring Blooming Blue


Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.
All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - Cut (2) 3-7/8" strips, subcut (12) 3-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 24 triangles] and (5) 3-1/2" squares
Cut (8) 2" strips

Fabric B - Cut (2) 3-7/8" strips, subcut (20) 3-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 40 triangles
Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (8) 3-1/2" squares
Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end then cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 75-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 67-1/2" borders

Fabric C - Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (40) 3-1/2" squares
Cut (7) 2" strips


Fabric D - Cut (2) 3-7/8" strips, subcut (12) 3-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 24 triangles
Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (12) 3-1/2" squares
Cut (8) 2" strips

Fabric E - Cut (3) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (32) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric F - Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (46) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric G - Cut (8) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (86) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric H - Cut (6) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (64) 3-1/2" squares

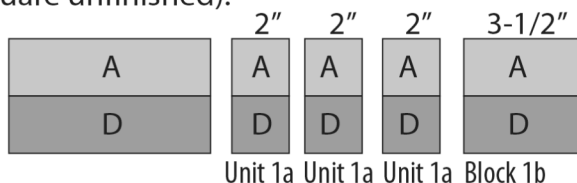
Fabric I - Cut (2) 3-7/8" strips, subcut (20) 3-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 40 triangles
Cut (7) 2" strips

Fabric J - Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (24) 3-1/2" squares

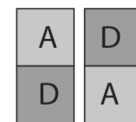
Fabric K - Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

2. Piecing Order:

1. Stitch **Fabrics A** and **D** 2" strips together lengthwise. Make a total of 8 strip sets. From these, cut (152) 2" wide Unit 1a (2" x 3-1/2" unfinished) and (4) 3-1/2" wide **Block 1b** (3-1/2" square unfinished).

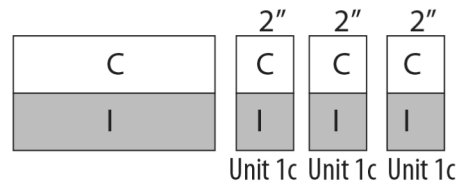


2. Arrange 2 Unit 1a with fabrics alternating. Sew units together. Make a total of 76 **Block 1a** (3-1/2" square unfinished).



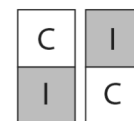

3. Stitch **Fabrics C** and **I** 2" strips together lengthwise.



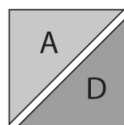
Make a total of 7 strip sets. From these, cut (128) 2" wide Unit 1c (2" x 3-1/2" unfinished).

4. Arrange 2 Unit 1c with fabrics alternating. Sew units together. Make a total of 64 **Block 1c** (3-1/2" square unfinished).

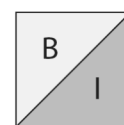

5. Sew 1 each **Fabrics A** and **D** 3-7/8" triangles along their long edges. Make a total of 24 **Block 2a** (3-1/2" square unfinished). Repeat with **Fabrics B** and **I** to make 40 **Block 2b**.

6. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 2) for arrangement and placement of 3-1/2" squares, blocks, and borders.

7. Arrange 3-1/2" squares and blocks in 25 rows of 21 blocks and squares. Sew into rows. Sew rows together to complete quilt center (63-1/2" x 75-1/2" unfinished).

8. Stitch 2-1/2" x 75-1/2" **Fabric B** borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add 2-1/2" x 67-1/2" **Fabric B** borders to top and bottom.

9. The quilt measures approximately 67-1/2" x 79-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric L**) at least 8" larger than the top.

10. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric K**) and enjoy!!
