



## **BASIC Table Topper #7 - Version 3**

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Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

#### 1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

**Fabric A** - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (4) 5-1/2" x 64" stripe borders

Fabric B - Cut (5) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 51-1/2" and (2) 2" x 48-1/2" borders

Fabric C - Cut (1) 8-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 8-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for 8 triangles

Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric D - Cut (1) 17-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 17-1/4" square then cut in half 
diagonally twice for 4 triangles

Fabric E - Cut (1) 8-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 8-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for 4 triangles

Cut (1) 8-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 8-1/2" squares

Fabric F - Cut (1) 17-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 17-1/4" square then cut in half diagonally twice for 4 triangles. Cut remaining strip into (2) 8-1/2" x 20" strips, subcut (4) 8-1/2" squares.

Cut (1) 8-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 8-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for 8 triangles


**Fabric G** - Cut (1) 11-7/8" strip, subcut (1) 11-7/8" square

Cut (1) 8-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 8-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for 8 triangles

Fabric H - Cut (1) 8-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 8-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for 8 triangles

#### 2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew long edges of 11-7/8" **Fabric E** triangles to the **Fabric G** square. Make 1 **Block 1** (16-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 1 - Make 1

2. Sew **Fabric G** 8-7/8" triangles to short edges of a **Fabric F** 17-1/4" triangle as shown. Make a total of 4 Unit 1 (8-1/2" x 16-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 1 each Units 2a-2d with fabrics indicated.

Unit 2b - Make 1



3. Sew a Unit 1 to each of Units 2a-2d as shown. Make a total of 1 each **Blocks 2a-2d** (16-1/2" square unfinished).









Shading of diagrams may vary depending on fabrics used.


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4. Stitch 1 each Fabrics F and H 8-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 8 Unit 3 (8-1/2" square unfinished).



5. Arrange 2 Unit 3 and 1 each Fabrics E and F 8-1/2" squares in 2 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 Block 3 (16-1/2" square unfinished).




- 6. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.
- 7. Arrange blocks in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (48-1/2" square unfinished).
- 8. Sew Fabric B 2" x 48-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add Fabric B 2"x 51-1/2" borders to top and bottom of guilt center.
- 9. Center **Fabric A** 5-1/2" x 64" borders on all sides of quilt center with top edge next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. 1/4" Do not trim. Press detail borders out.  $\stackrel{A}{\rightarrow}$

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric. Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

10. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



- 11. The guilt measures approximately 61-1/2" square (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric I**) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 12. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric C) and enjoy!!

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#### **QUILT LAYOUT**

Border measurements are the cut size.

Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

Shading of Quilt Layout may vary depending on fabrics used.
