Throw Quilt: 56 1/2" x 76 1/2"

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Country Cardinals


Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

PLEASE NOTE:


Cut all 4-7/8" squares in half diagonally for the  number of triangles indicated in [].


Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.


Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23-1/2" x 42"


Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 8-3/4" x 55" (both with narrow stripe on top) and (2) 8-3/4" x 35" (1 with narrow stripe on top, 1 with narrow stripe on bottom) multi-stripe borders

Fabric C - Cut (1) 8-3/4" strip, subcut (4) 8-3/4" squares

Fabrics D and K - From each fabric: Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (7) 4-7/8" squares *cut only as shown*  [14]

Fabrics E and H - From each fabric: Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (6) 4-7/8" squares *cut only as shown*  [12]

Fabric F - Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (7) 4-7/8"  [14]
Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (8) 3" squares

Fabric G - Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (6) 4-7/8" squares  [12]

Fabric I - Cut (7) 3-1/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3-1/4" x 71-1/2" and (2) 3-1/4" x 57" borders

Fabric J - Cut (2) 2-1/4" strips, subcut (2) 2-1/4" x 26 strips
Cut (2) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (2) 1-3/4" x 35 borders
Cut (3) 1-3/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-3/4" x 52-1/2" borders
Cut (2) 1-1/2" strips

Fabric L - Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

NOTE: Not all **Fabrics D and K** triangles are used.

2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew 1 each **Fabrics F and K** 4-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 7 **Block 1** (4-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 7 **Block 2** and 6 each **Blocks 3-6**.

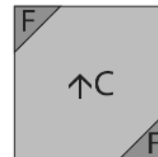
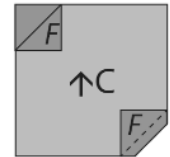

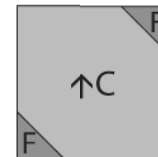
2. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all the **Fabric F** 3" squares. 

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

3. Arrange 2 **Fabric F** 3" marked squares on opposite corners of a **Fabric C** 8-3/4" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Make a total of 2 each **Blocks 7a and 7b** (8-3/4" square unfinished).

4. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of panel, strips, blocks, and borders.

5. Stitch **Fabric J** 1-1/2" x width of fabric strips to sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 2-1/4" x 26" **Fabric J** strips to top and bottom of panel. *Trim bordered panel to 24-1/2" x 44-1/2" (unfinished).*

6. Arrange 1 **Block 1** and 2 each **Blocks 2-6** in a vertical row on left side of bordered panel. Stitch into vertical row (4-1/2" x 44-1/2" unfinished). Sew to left side of bordered panel.

7. Arrange 1 **Block 2** and 2 each **Blocks 1** and 3-6 in a vertical row on right side of bordered panel. Stitch into vertical row (4-1/2" x 44-1/2" unfinished). Sew to right side of bordered panel.

8. Arrange 2 each **Blocks 1** and **2** and 1 each **Blocks 3-6** in horizontal rows above and below bordered panel. Stitch into horizontal rows (4-1/2" x 32-1/2" unfinished). Sew to top and bottom of bordered panel.

9. Sew **Fabric J** 1-3/4" x 52-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric J** 1-3/4" x 35" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

10. Sew **Fabric B** 8-3/4" x 55" borders to right and left sides of quilt.

11. Sew 1 each **Blocks 7a** and **7b** to ends of each **Fabric B** 8-3/4" x 35" border (8-3/4" x 51-1/2" finished). Stitch borders to top and bottom of quilt.

12. Sew **Fabric I** 3-1/4" x 71-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric I** 3-1/4" x 57" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

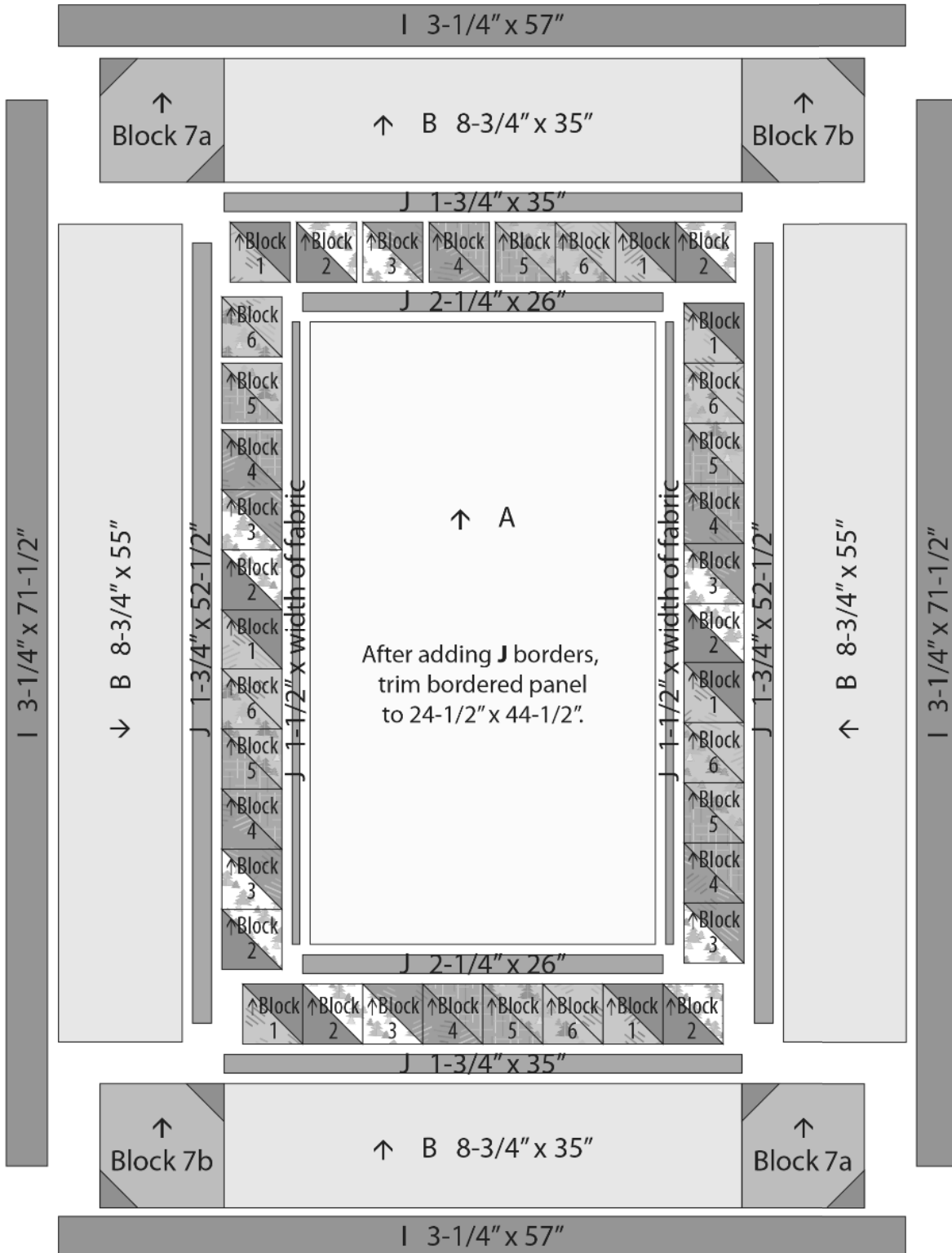
13. The quilt measures approximately 57" x 77" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric M**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

14. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric L**) and enjoy!!

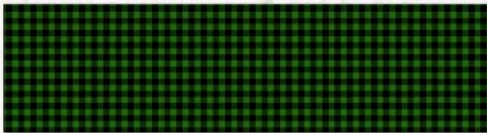
