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Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (4) 3-1/2" x 40" and (4) 3-1/2" x 30" floral stripe borders

Fabric B - Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (4) 2-3/4" x 5" pieces, (4) 4" squares and (4) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric C - Cut (1) 3-1/4" strip, subcut (12) 3-1/4" squares

Cut (2) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (24) 2-3/4" squares

Fabric D - Cut (1) 3-1/4" strip, subcut (12) 3-1/4" squares

Fabric E - Cut (1) 4" strip, subcut (8) 4" squares
Cut (1) 2-3/4" strip, subcut (8) 2-3/4" x 5" pieces

Fabric F - Cut (1) 4" strip, subcut (4) 4" squares and (4) 3-1/2" squares
Cut (1) 3-1/4" strip, subcut (12) 3-1/4" squares
Cut (1) 2-3/4" strip, subcut (4) 2-3/4" x 5" pieces and (8) 2-3/4" squares

Fabric G - Cut (1) 2-3/4" strip, subcut (8) 2-3/4" squares
Cut (2) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 21" strips

Fabric H - Cut (1) 3-1/4" strip, subcut (12) 3-1/4" squares
Cut (3) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (24) 2-3/4" x 5" pieces

Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (14) 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" strips

Fabric I - Cut (2) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (24) 2-3/4" squares

Fabric J - Cut (2) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (1) 1-1/2" x 21" strip

Fabric K - Cut (2) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 1-1/2" squares

Fabric L - Cut (1) 2-3/4" strip, subcut (8) 2-3/4" squares

Fabric M - Cut (2) 25-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 25-1/2" x 21" backings

2. Piecing Order:

1. On the wrong side of all **Fabrics F** and **H** 3-1/4" squares and all **Fabrics B** and **F** 4" squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Draw 2 lines 1/4" on each side of first line.

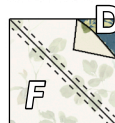


Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

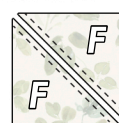
2. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all the **Fabrics C, F, G, I,** and **L** 2-3/4" squares.



3. Arrange a marked **Fabric F** 3-1/4" square right sides together with a **Fabric D** 3-1/4" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 2-3/4" square. Make a total of 24 Unit 1a. In the same manner, make 24 Unit 1b with fabrics indicated.



Repeat 12 times for 24 units.

4. Arrange 4 Unit 1a in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 Unit 2a and 2 Unit 2b (5" square unfinished).

5. Arrange a marked **Fabric C** 2-3/4" square on 1 end of a **Fabric H** 2-3/4" x 5" piece as shown. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner out. Repeat on other end with a marked **Fabric I** 2-3/4" square. Make a total of 16 Unit 3a (2-3/4" x 5" unfinished).



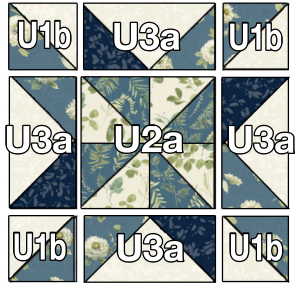

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6. In the same manner, make 8 Unit 3b with fabrics indicated.



7. Arrange 4 Unit 1b, 1 Unit 2a, and 4 Unit 3a in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 1a** (9-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 2 **Block 1b** with units indicated.



8. Arrange a marked **Fabric L** 2-3/4" square on 1 end of a **Fabric F** 2-3/4" x 5" piece as shown. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner out. Repeat on other end with a marked **Fabric G** 2-3/4" square. Make a total of 4 Unit 4a (2-3/4" x 5" unfinished).



9. In the same manner, make 4 each Units 4b and 4c with fabrics indicated.



10. Stitch a Unit 4a and **Fabric B** 2-3/4" x 5" piece together as shown. Make a total of 4 Unit 5 (5" square unfinished).



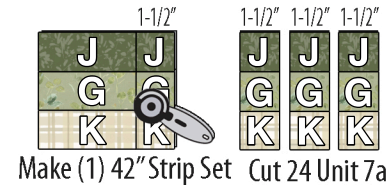
11. Arrange 2 each Units 5, 4b, and 4c in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 2 **Block 2** (9-1/2" square unfinished).



12. Arrange a marked **Fabric F** 4" square right sides together with a **Fabric E** 4" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 3-1/2" square. Make a total of 8 Unit 6a. In the same manner, make 8 Unit 6b with fabrics indicated.



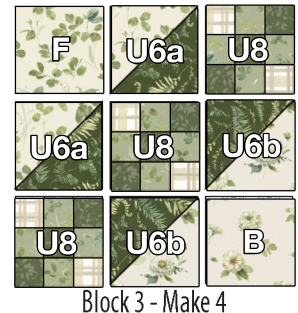
13. Stitch a **Fabric G** 1-1/2" x width of fabric strip between 1 each **Fabrics J** and **K** 1-1/2" x width of fabric strips. From these, cut (24) 1-1/2" wide Unit 7a (1-1/2" x 3-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make (1) 3-1/2" x 21" strip set and cut 12 Unit 7b with fabrics indicated.



14. Stitch a Unit 7b between 2 Unit 7a. Make a total of 12 Unit 8 (3-1/2" square unfinished).



15. Arrange 1 each **Fabrics B** and **F** 3-1/2" squares, 2 Unit 6a, 2 Unit 6b, and 3 Unit 8 in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 3** (9-1/2" square unfinished).



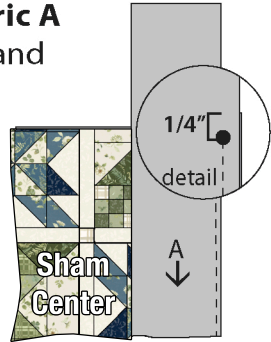
16. Refer to Sham Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of **Fabric K** 1-1/2" squares, **Fabric H** 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" strips, blocks, and borders.

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

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17. Arrange 2 **Block 1a**, 1 **Block 1b**, 1 **Block 2**, and 2 **Block 3**, 2 **Fabric K** 1-1/2" squares, and 7 **Fabric H** 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" strips in 3 rows. Sew into rows. Stitch rows together. Make a total of 2 sham centers (19-1/2" x 29-1/2" unfinished).

18. Center **Fabric A** 3-1/2" x 30" borders on right and left sides and **Fabric A** 3-1/2" x 40" borders on top and bottom of sham center, referring to sham image for positioning of stripe. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



22. Fold and press 1/4" to wrong side on a 25-1/2" edge of 1 **Fabric M** back piece. Fold and press 1/2" to wrong side on the same edge. Top stitch hem in place. Make 4 Back Units (20-1/4" x 25-1/2" unfinished).



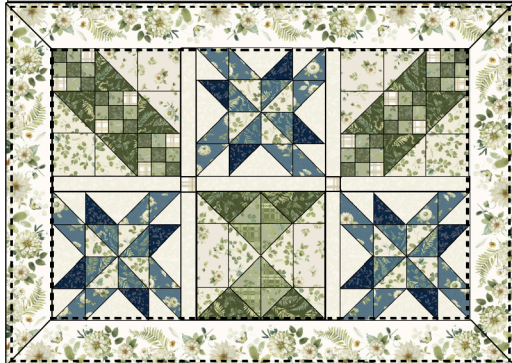
Back Units - Make 4

23. Lay a pillow sham top right side up. Arrange 1 Back Unit wrong side up on 1 end with hem in the center, aligning all raw edges. Pin in place. Arrange a second Back Unit on the other end with the hemmed edge overlapping the hem of the pinned Back Unit and aligning all raw edges. Pin. Stitch around outer edges, through all layers.



24. Turn pillow sham right side out. Press edges. Top stitch outside edge of sham if desired.

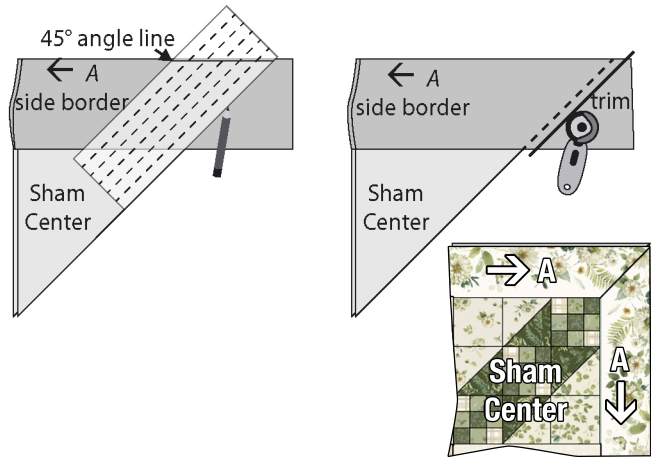
25. Top stitch along seams between **Fabric A** and the sham center creating a 3" flange. Insert a 20" x 30" pillow.



26. Repeat Steps 23-25 to add the backing and finish the second sham.

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric. Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

19. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



20. If desired, layer with a 29" x 39" lining (not included in yardage) and batting. Quilt as desired. Trim lining and batting even with sham top.

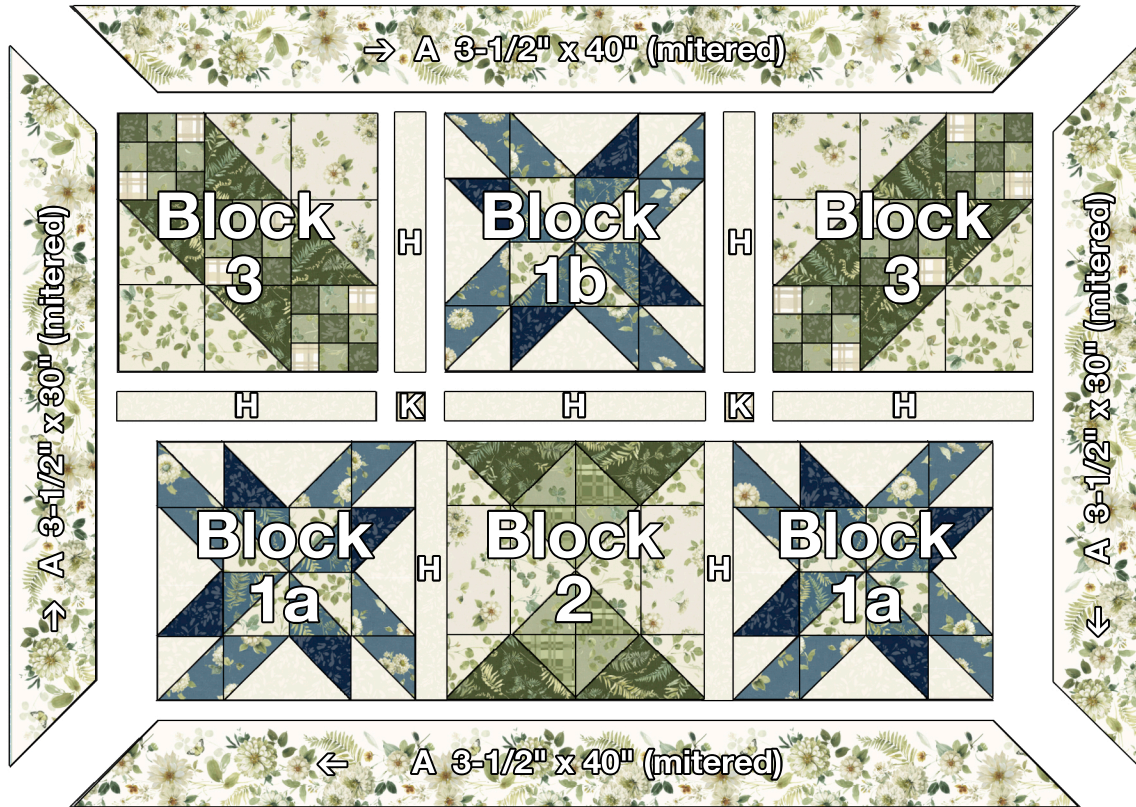
21. Referring to Steps 18-20, complete a second sham top.
