Our Gnome to Yours


Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. WOF= width of fabric.
All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

PLEASE NOTE:


Cut all 4-7/8" and 3-3/4" squares in half diagonally once for the number of triangles indicated in []. 


Cut all 2-5/8" squares in half diagonally twice for the number of triangles indicated in []. 

Fabric A - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 5-1/2" x 80" and (2) 5-1/2" x 68" gnome stripe borders

Fabric B - Cut (2) 6-1/8" strips, subcut (6) 6-1/8" squares and (4) 3-3/8" wide x 6-1/8" tall pieces. From remainder of strip cut (1) 3-3/8" x 30", subcut (3) 3-3/8" tall x 6-1/8" wide pieces and (2) 3-3/8" squares.

Fabric C - see cutting diagram page 3

Fabric D - Cut (2) 5" strips, subcut (10) 5" squares and (4) 3-3/4" squares  [8]


Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (8) 4-7/8" squares  [16]

Fabrics E, F, G, and I - Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (1) 2-1/2" x 21" strip

Fabric H - Cut (2) 5" strips, subcut (10) 5" squares


Fabric J - Cut (3) 8-1/2" strips, subcut (80) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips


Cut (3) 5" strips, subcut (20) 5" squares and (5) 3-3/4" squares  [10]

Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (8) 4-7/8" squares  [16]

Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips, from 2 strips cut (4) 2-1/2" x 21" strips

Fabric K - Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Cut (1) 2-5/8" strip, subcut (2) 2-5/8" squares  [8] and (16) 1-1/2" squares

Fabric L - Cut (1) 2-5/8" strip, subcut (3) 2-5/8" squares  [6] and (15) 1-1/2" squares

Fabric M - Cut (6) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 64" and (2) 2" x 54-1/2" border

NOTE: Not all **Fabric J** 4-7/8" triangles and **Fabric L** 2-5/8" triangles are used.

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

2. Piecing Order:

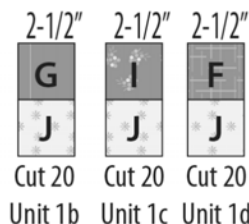
1. Stitch 1 each **Fabrics E** and **J** 2-1/2" x WOF strips together lengthwise. Stitch 1 each **Fabrics E** and **J** 2-1/2" x 21" strips together lengthwise. From these, cut (20) 2-1/2" wide Unit 1a (2-1/2" x 4-1/2" unfinished).



Make (1) WOF and (1) 21" Strip Set

Cut 20 Unit 1a

2. In the same manner, make 1 each WOF and 21" **G/J**, **I/J**, and **F/J** strip sets and cut 20 each Units 1b-1d with fabrics indicated.

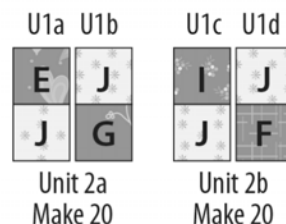

3. Stitch 1 each Units 1a and 1b together alternating **J** squares. Make a total of 20 Unit 2a (4-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 20 Unit 2b with units indicated.



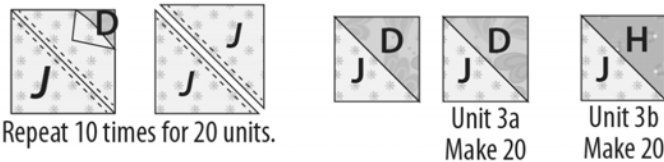

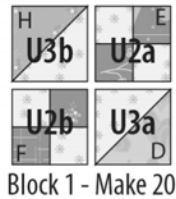
4. On the wrong side of all **Fabric J** 5" squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Draw 2 lines 1/4" on each side of first line.

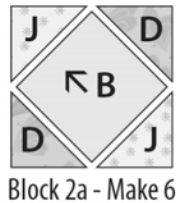
5. Arrange a marked **Fabric J** 5" square right sides together with a **Fabric D** 5" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 4-1/2" square. Make a total of 20 Unit 3a. In the same manner, make 20 Unit 3b with fabrics indicated.



6. Arrange 1 each Units 2a, 2b, 3a, and 3b in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 20 **Block 1** (8-1/2" square unfinished).

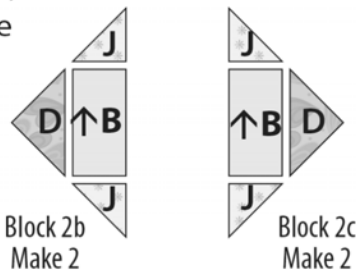


7. Sew 2 each **Fabrics J** and **D** 4-7/8" triangles to edges of a **Fabric B** 6-1/8" square as shown. Make a total of 6 **Block 2a** (8-1/2" square unfinished).



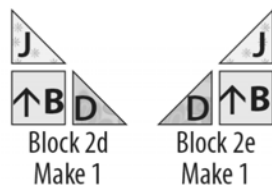
Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

8. Stitch a **Fabric D** 4-7/8" triangle to a long edge of a **Fabric B** 3-3/8" x 6-1/8" piece. Add a **Fabric J** 3-3/4" triangle to short edges as shown to make 2 each **Blocks 2b** and **2c**

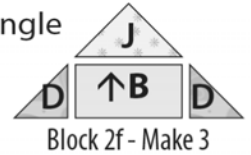


Blocks 2b and **2c** (8-7/8" x 8-7/8" x 12-1/2" unfinished). Baste 1/8" from short edges of each block to prevent stretching.

9. Stitch 1 each **Fabrics J** and **D** 3-3/4" triangles to adjoining edges of a **Fabric B** 3-3/8" square as shown to make 1 each **Blocks 2d** and **2e** (6-1/2" x 6-1/2" x 9-1/8" unfinished). Baste 1/8" from long edge to prevent stretching.



10. Stitch a **Fabric J** 4-7/8" triangle to top edge of a **Fabric B** 3-3/8" x 6-1/8" piece. Add a **Fabric D** 3-3/4" triangle to short edges as shown to make 3 **Block 2f** (8-7/8" x 8-7/8" x 12-1/2" unfinished). Baste 1/8" from short edges of each block to prevent stretching.

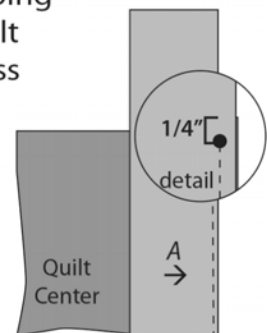


11. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of blocks, squares, triangles, sashing strips, cornerstone squares, cornerstone triangles, and borders.

12. Arrange blocks, **Fabric C** 8-1/2" squares, **Fabric C** triangles, **Fabric J** 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" sashing strips, **Fabrics K** and **L** 1-1/2" square cornerstones, **Fabrics K** and **L** 2-5/8" cornerstone triangles in 19 diagonal rows. Stitch into diagonal rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (51-1/2" x 64" unfinished).

13. Sew **Fabric M** 2" x 64" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric M** 2" x 54-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

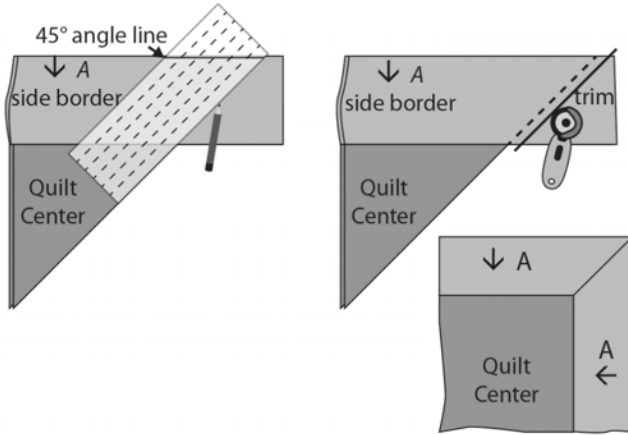
14. Center **Fabric A** 5-1/2" x 80" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric A** 5-1/2" x 68" borders on top and bottom of quilt center noting orientation of stripe. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.
Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

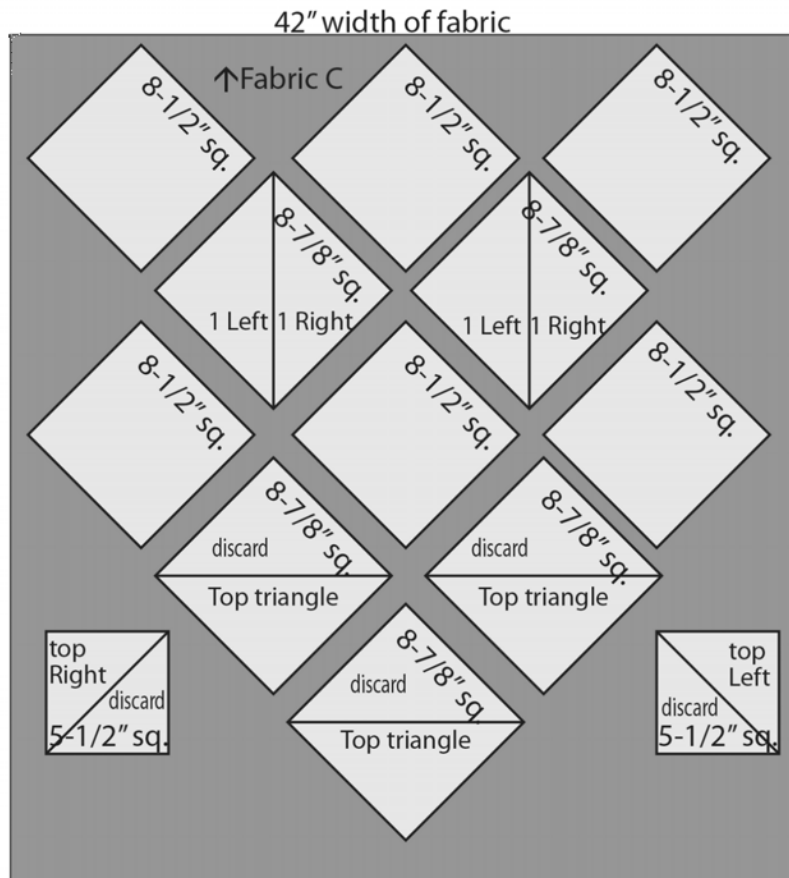

15. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



16. The quilt measures approximately 64-1/2" x 77" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric N**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

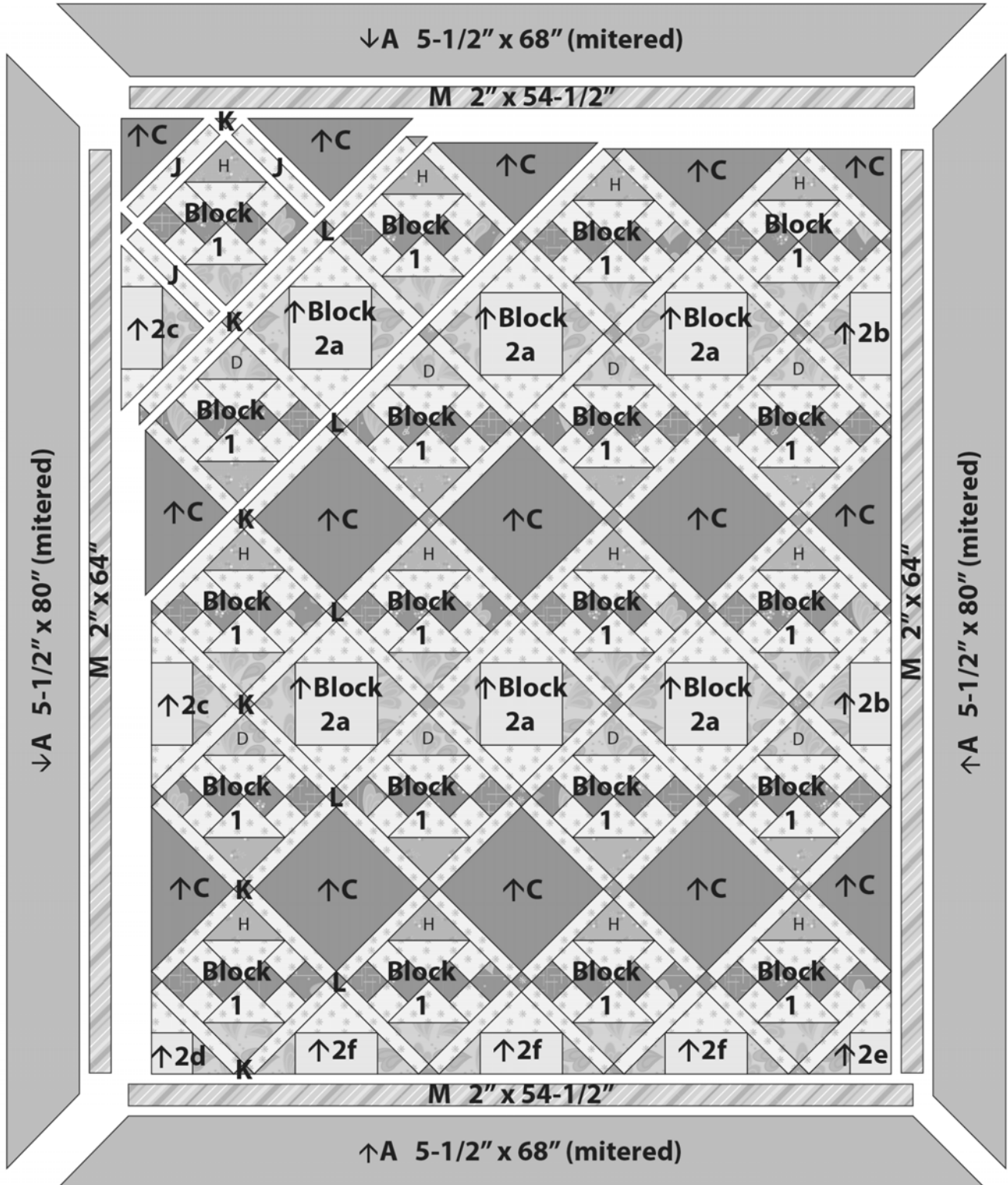
17. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric K**) and enjoy!!
